

Curbside Garbage
Service Guidelines

City of Woodbine
Public Works Department

The following items will be picked up weekly on the designated pick up day for your area. These items must be set up at curbside prior to 6:30 am for the pick-up.

GARBAGE

WHITE GOODS (Fridays)

BULKY ITEMS

- You will be provided with a 90-gallon garbage container on wheels.
- Household garbage will be picked up once a week on the designated day for your area.
- Only Household garbage should be dispensed of in the container provided.
- Up to 2 additional standard 32 gallon size containers may be purchased and used.
- The following items cannot be mixed with household garbage:

Dirt	Gas Tanks	Ashes	Paint
Yard Waste	Construction debris	Batteries	Bricks
Scrap Metal	Dead Animals	Concrete	
Shingles	Tires	Oil	

Any other hazardous waste or item deemed unacceptable by the E.P.D. or the City of Woodbine.

- Bulky items will be picked up from the curb of the residence generating the bulky item. These items will be picked up with your household garbage. Bulky items are items such as mattresses, box springs, chairs, couches, tables, microwaves, and televisions. Please call Woodbine City Hall to schedule pick-up.
- White Good will be picked up at the curb of the residence generating the appliance. White goods are picked up by appointment. You must call Woodbine City Hall to schedule the Friday pick up. White goods include refrigerators, freezers, stoves, and air conditioners.

Yard Waste cannot be mixed with household garbage. The City of Woodbine offers this service with your Garbage account and pick-up is on Thursdays and Fridays.

Recyclables

Will collect the following recyclables-

Plastic 1 & 2 Glass bottles & jars Brown bags Metal cans
Aluminum cans Newspaper & inserts Telephone Books
Corrugated cardboard (flattened & cut in 2 feet by 3 feet pieces for placement under the recycle bin)

- These also need to be placed by the curbside on your designated day in the recycle bin provided.
- If you fill your bin, please put the additional recyclables in a paper bag and sit them beside your bin
- All plastics jars & bottles must be emptied, rinsed and lids removed before placing them in the bin. Metal & aluminum cans need to be crushed.
- The following items will not be accepted- pizza boxes, plastic bags, butter tubs, juice and milk cardboard cartons, egg cartons, Styrofoam, magazines, catalogs, pool or other chemical containers.
