The regular meeting of the Woodbine City Council held on June 3, 2019 was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Parrott, with the following Councilors present: C.C. Old Business:

Robbie Cheek with Thomas & Hutton presented a proposed Request for Proposal (RFP) for landscaping City Hall. Mr. Cheek and the Council discussed the details and parameters of the RFP. Mr. Cheek stated that the winning bid will provide a plan for maintaining the landscape once complete. Motion made by C. C. Higginbotham, Jr., seconded by, Donald Harrelson, to approve the RFP with a not to exceed budget of \$15,000.00 and \$3,500.00 for engineering. Motion was unanimously approved and so declared by Mayor Parrott.

Robbie Cheek advised that the Trestle repairs RFP did not receive any response from bidders. He stated that he will put the RFP back out to bid and contact contractors to bring attention to the project. Mr. Cheek and the Council discussed building materials and cost of work. The Council agreed to put it out to bid again for 60 days.

Mayor Parrott stated that he would like to try allowing chickens as presented in the proposed ordinance change for a trial basis of 1 year. Councilor Higginbotham asked that the number of chickens be changed to 6. Motion made by C. C. Higginbotham, Jr., seconded by, Donald Harrelson, to make requested changes to the ordinances and bring them to the July 8, 2019 City Council Meeting for a first reading. Motion was unanimously approved and so declared by Mayor Parrott.
