City of Woodbine Garbage Service Guidelines

Garbage

- Pick-up is Monday (Tuesdays also as needed). Ensure can is curbside prior to 6:30 am for pick-up.
- A 90-gallon wheeled container is provided. A second container is available for an additional charge of \$11.00 per month.
- Only Household garbage should be dispensed of in the container(s) provided.

Bulk & White Goods Collection

- Bulk Item pick-up is Monday with regular trash pick-up. Requests must be made to City Hall prior to the Monday
 pick-up date. THESE REQUIRE A WORK ORDER TO BE SUBMITTED BY CITY HALL. Items without a Work Order will
 not be picked up.
- White Goods (Appliances) will be picked up on Fridays. THESE REQUIRE A WORK ORDER TO BE SUBMITTED BY CITY HALL. Items without a Work Order will not be picked up.
- ***Accepted Items: Mattresses, sofas, chairs, bicycles, appliances, other furniture items and BBQ grills.***
- Items NOT Accepted: Cabinetry, concrete, concrete poles, cement, construction & demolition debris, decking, fencing, drywall, fluorescent light bulbs, all types of flooring, glass/mirrors, land clearing debris, lumber, metal/metal pipes, paint, block pavers, stepping stones, pool parts/equipment, rocks, sand, soil, sod, roofing materials, sheds (wood/metal), all types of tile, tree stumps, and wood/railroad ties/logs/pallets.
- CALL TO VERIFY THE ITEMS ARE ALLOWED TO BE PICKED UP.

Yard Waste Collection

- The City of Woodbine provides this service with your Water/Sewer/Garbage account. Pick-up is on Thursdays and Fridays.
- Standard yard debris only.
- Land clearing debris will NOT be picked up by the City.
- DEBRIS CAN NOT BE PICKED UP IF PLACED UNDER POWER LINES

Recyclables

- The following items will be collected:
 - Plastic 1&2, Glass bottles/jars, brown bags, metal cans, aluminum cans, newspapers & inserts, telephone books. Corrugated cardboard (flattened and & cut in 2 feet by 3 feet pieces, placed in or under the recycle bin). These items also need to be placed by the curbside on your designated day in the recycle bin provided. If the bin is filled, please place additional recyclables in a paper bag and sit them beside your bin.
- All plastic jars and bottles must be emptied, rinsed and lids removed before placing them in the bin.
- Metal and aluminum cans need to be crushed.
- The following items will NOT be accepted: pizza boxes, plastic bags, butter tubs, juice and milk cardboard cartons, egg cartons, Styrofoam, magazines, catalogs, pool and other chemical containers.
