

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
WOODBINE CITY COUNCIL
June 5, 2023

Motion made by Phyllis Drummond, seconded by Louise Mitchell to go into Executive Session.

The Regular Meeting reconvened at 7:46 p.m.


Mayor Knight advised that no votes were taken and no decisions were made during Executive Session.
